Darrell stated that the Dinner Bell in Gold Creek was still open despite rumors, and he has made tentative reservations on July 11th.


Pretty short meeting, with only the President, Secretary and two members attending, so that was all the business that was discussed. *Darrell*

Also, it had an extremely long hood, secured with a leather strap. The engine was a 302 cubic inch displacement with 35-40 HP. Only two are known to exist.

I used 2x6 tongue and groove decking. The inside of the deck is redwood (used that I had). The outside is fir. I made all of the tongues and grooves with a router since I could not find 2x6 tongue and groove decking. I replaced the underpinning with fir 4x4s. I treated it on all sides with water seal on all edges as I put it down.
